CRIME OF THE WEEK

The Lodi Police Department is asking for the public's assistance regarding the bank robbery at Bank of the West, which occurred Friday, May 16th.



The woman pictured on the left was responsible for this bank robbery. She has been described as being around 5'4" tall; perhaps Hispanic, with a solid build, and approximately 30 years of age. As shown in the picture, she wore sunglasses and a hat during the robbery.

If you were at the Bank of the West during the robbery, and have not talked with the Police Department about this crime, we urge you to call us with your information.

You may remain anonymous by contacting Lodi Area Crimes Stoppers at 333-6771, and be eligible to receive a cash reward up to \$1,000. If you choose no to remain anonymous, please call Detective Ramirez at 333-6872.

All wanted persons featured are presumed innocent unless convicted in a court of law. Persons featured in this wanted ad have confirmed arrest warrants at the time the ad is printed. All warrant information must be rechecked at the time of contact to insure a valid arrest warrant still exists. Calls made on the Crime Stoppers phone line are anonymous and a cash reward up to \$1,000 may be issued for information leading to an arrest of a wanted person.
